## Dear Mr. Umbdenstock:

Thank you for providing a copy of your proposed Salvage and Marine Firefighting Service Agreement for our review. The Coast Guard appreciates your proactive efforts to discuss the acceptability of your proposed Agreement titled "OPA 90 VESSEL RESPONSE PLAN CITATION & SALVAGE AND MARINE FIREFIGHTING FUNDING AGREEMENT" contained in your April 28, 2010 e-mail submission to Ms. Patricia Adams of my staff. When executed, this Agreement will designate Resolve as a salvage and marine firefighting response services contractor to a vessel owner/operator as required by the Salvage and Marine Firefighting Requirements; Vessel Response Plans for Oil; Final Rule dated December 31, 2008.

The proposed form of the Agreement, with the commercial terms and applicable rates included for specified services attached, if executed by the parties and submitted by a vessel owner/operator in support of their VRP revisions necessary for compliance with the aforementioned regulations, would be found to be acceptable by the Coast Guard in meeting the 33 Code of Federal Regulations 155.4025 definition "contract or other approved means," including the "funding agreement" component of that definition.

Thank you for providing the Coast Guard with an opportunity to review your proposed submission in advance. Your initiative and willingness to meet with my staff to discuss this matter will assist the Coast Guard as we develop national guidance on revising VRPs to meet the new regulatory requirements.
